
POWER ADAPTER AND CABLE

Button Functions




COLOR OPTIONS


- Warm - 3000K

NOTE: When the Studio Lamp is turned off, it will return to the previous settings.


Bottom Hinge Rotation: 60°




Bottom Hinge Tilt: 36°
